Read the question carefully and select how to find one part.	
If you have a total amount mentioned, add the parts of the ratio to find the total number of parts and then divide by that number of parts.	
If you have a difference mentioned, subtract one number of parts from the other. Divide the amount by that number of parts.	
If you are told what one thing is, just divide by the number of parts associated with that one thing.	
Find the value of one part.	
Multiply the number of parts by the value of one part to find the value for each person or item.
