Simon lives three streets away from Thomas and one street away from David, who also goes to the cubs with them.

Ethan, who is two years older than Thomas, lives next door. Ethan left the cubs when he was nine and now he just spends Tuesday evenings riding up and down his street on his bike.

Mary lives on the other side of Thomas. Mary is in Ethan's class at school, but has a younger brother, called Kylie, who goes to the cubs. Kylie is one year older than Thomas. Mary wants to ride her bike to school every day but has to wait to pass her cycling proficiency first.

Julie and James are both Sixers in the cubs. They are in charge of Black Six and White Six respectively. Although Julie lives on Ormondroyd Avenue, she goes to a different school to Thomas. James lives three streets away and is in Thomas' class at school. At weekends and in the holidays, Thomas and Julie both cycle round to James's house and play out with him. James, who does not own a bike, enjoys swimming.

Katie, Elliot and Harry live about half a mile away from Thomas, on Backwell Drive. They all attend scouts and go to the same high school. Elliot is allergic to peanuts. Harry and Katie both cycle to school.

At school, Emily's best friend sits next to her in class. Her name is Holly. Holly goes to the cubs but lives on hill on a road called Backwell Lane. Sometimes, her and Emily climb to the top of the hill with their bikes and then just freewheel down whilst screaming at the top of their voices. Sometimes Holly can't play out in early summer because she suffers from hayfever and is allergic to pollen.

Joanne and Amy live next door to each other on Ormondroyd Avenue. Joanne moved in about 8 weeks ago and initially spent all her time just moping about on her bike. One morning, Amy saw her and invited her in to play on a computer game. Since that day, they have been best friends and although they go to different schools, they meet up nearly every night when they get home. Amy is in Class Four.

Behind Ormondroyd Avenue is a street called St Paul's Close. Ronald and Andrew live there. They both go to school and are both in Class Four. Andrew has had to have a lot of time off recently, as she has been poorly due to her allergies. Luckily, she is back at school at the moment. Both children go to the local cub pack. Ronald has a bike, but hardly ever plays on it.

David used to love walking in the countryside, but has to be careful now since he was stung by a wasp. He was on cub camp at the time and ended up having to go to hospital. He is still in the cubs but has to take an Epipen with him everywhere he goes in order to make sure he is safe. David lives at 24 Ormondroyd Avenue. His next door neighbour, Ben, is in the cubs as well. Unlike David, Ben is in Class Four at the local school. He loves riding horses but also goes for long rides on his bike with his cousin.
